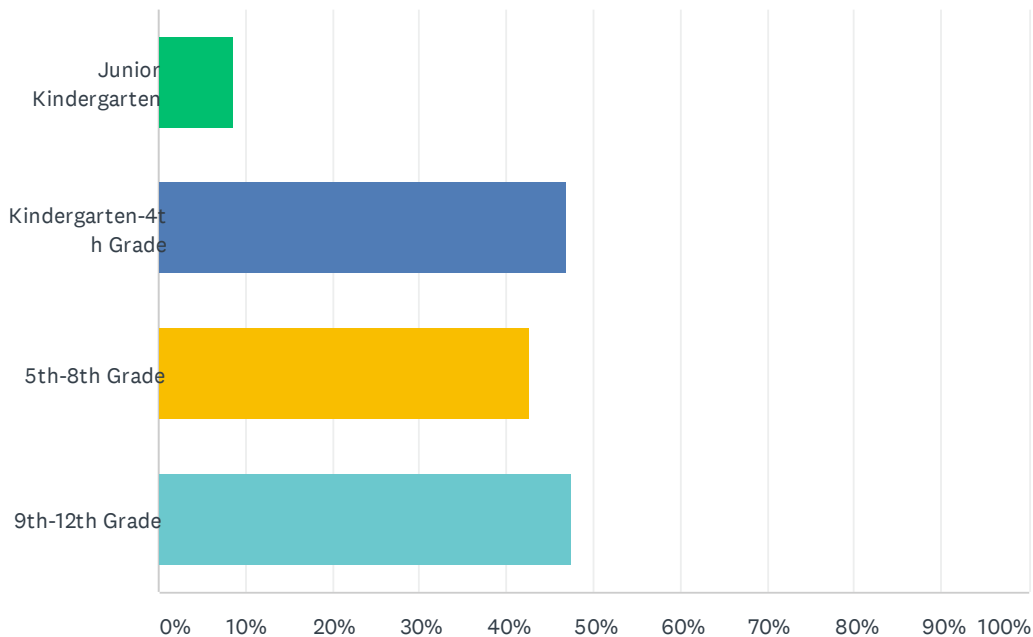

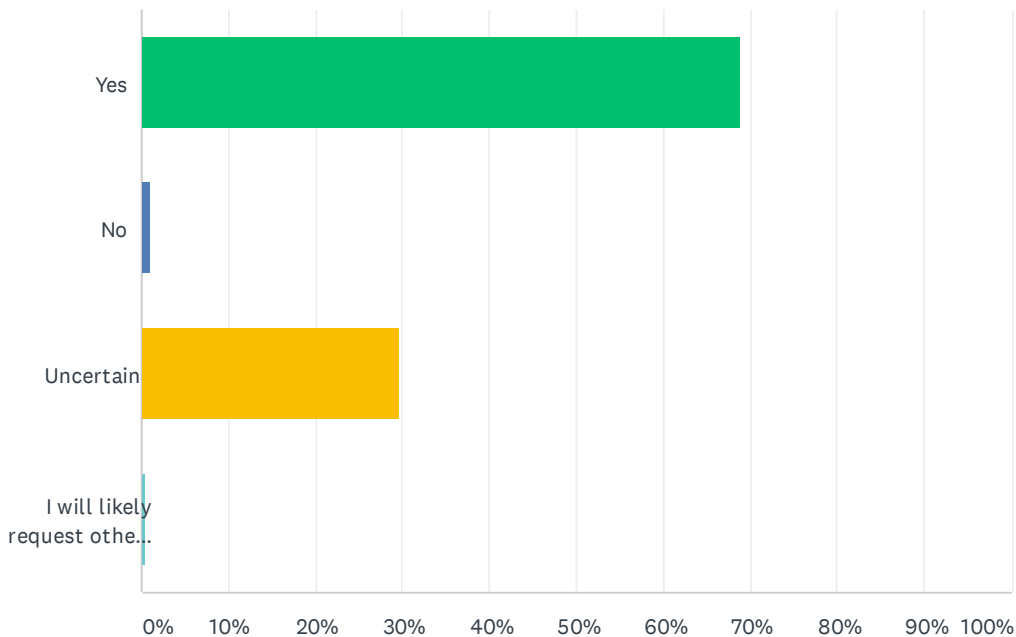

Q2 If schools are open in the fall, do you intend to send your child(ren)?

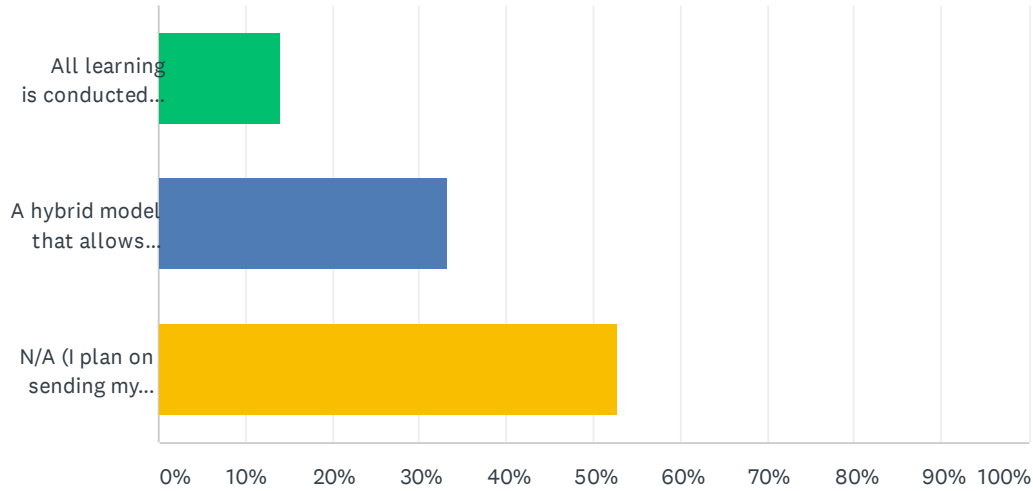

Q3 If you answered "No" or "Uncertain" to the previous question, please indicate which educational delivery option you most support for your child(ren).

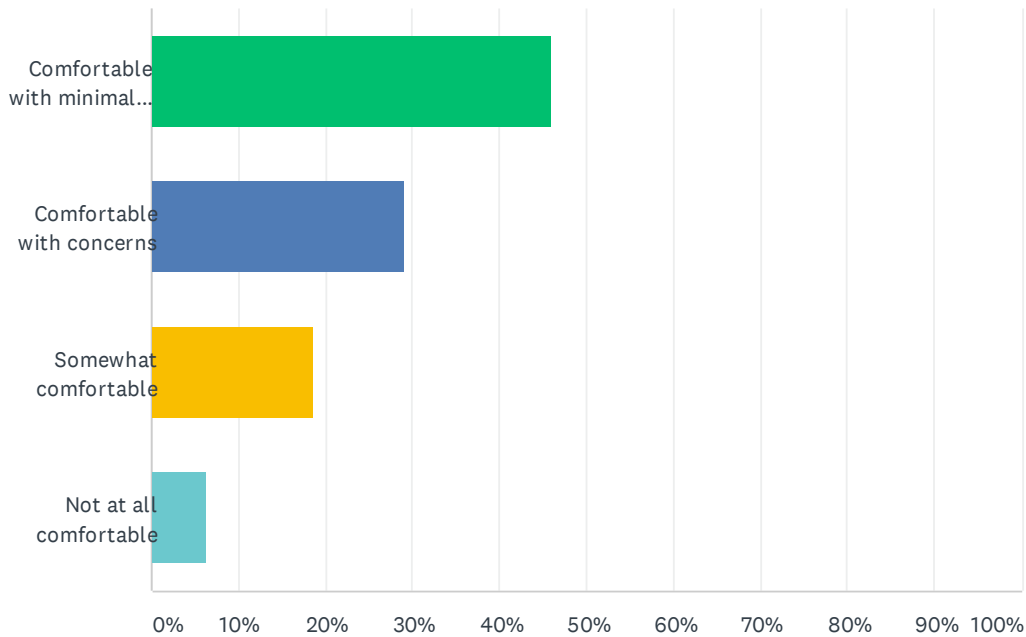

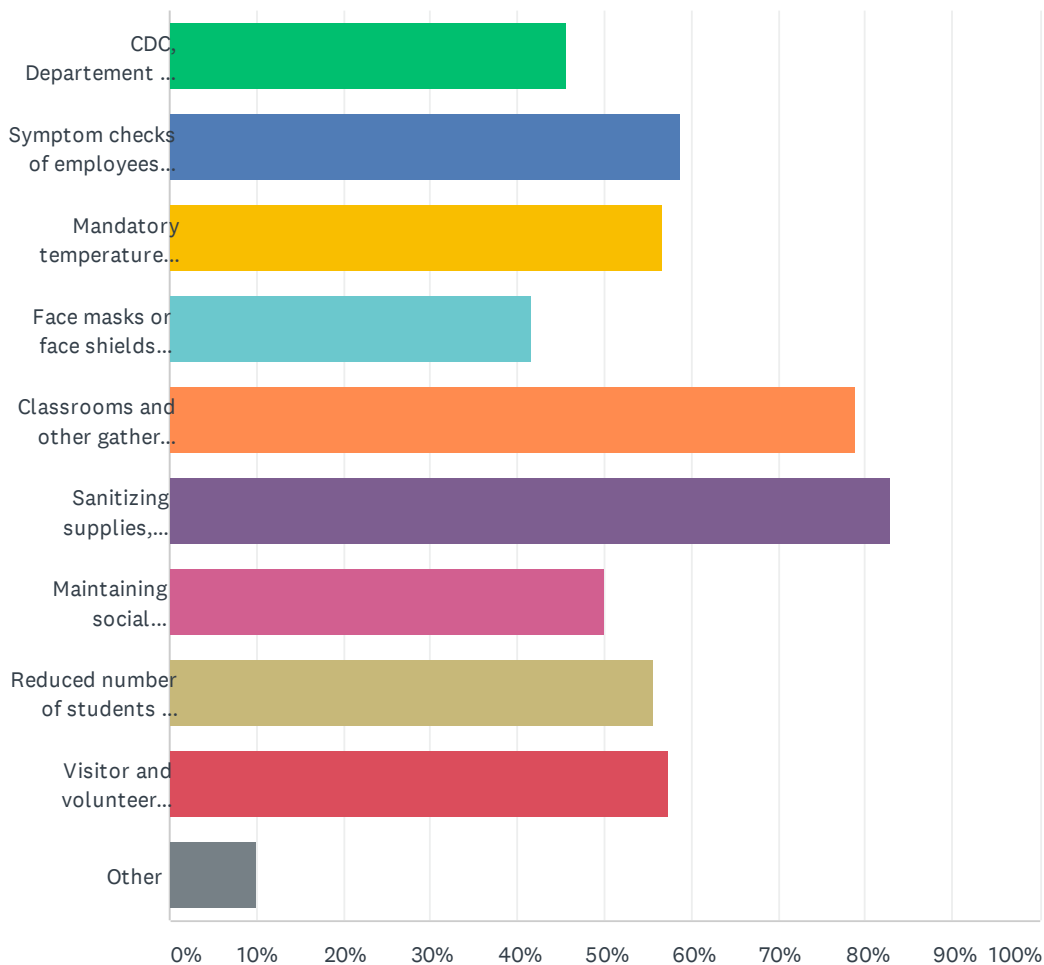

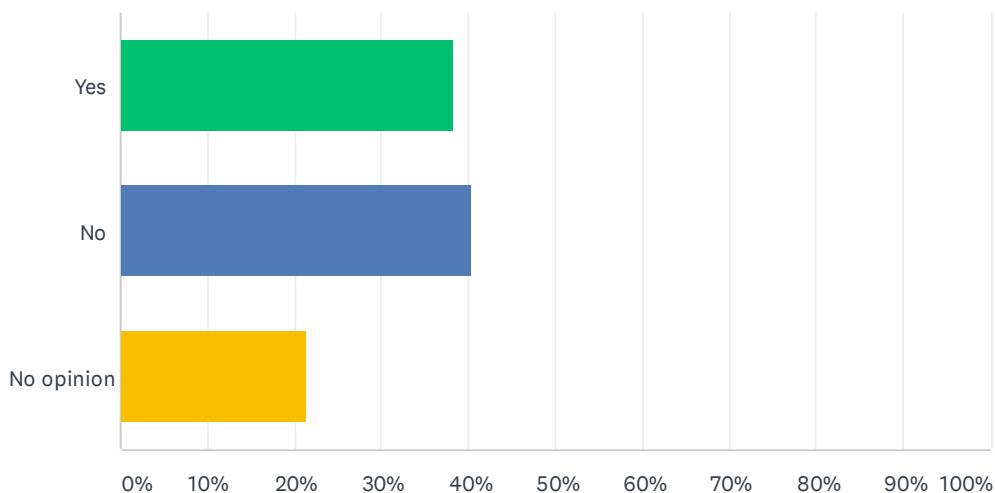

Q6 Would it increase your comfortable level if staff were required to wear face masks and/or face shields?

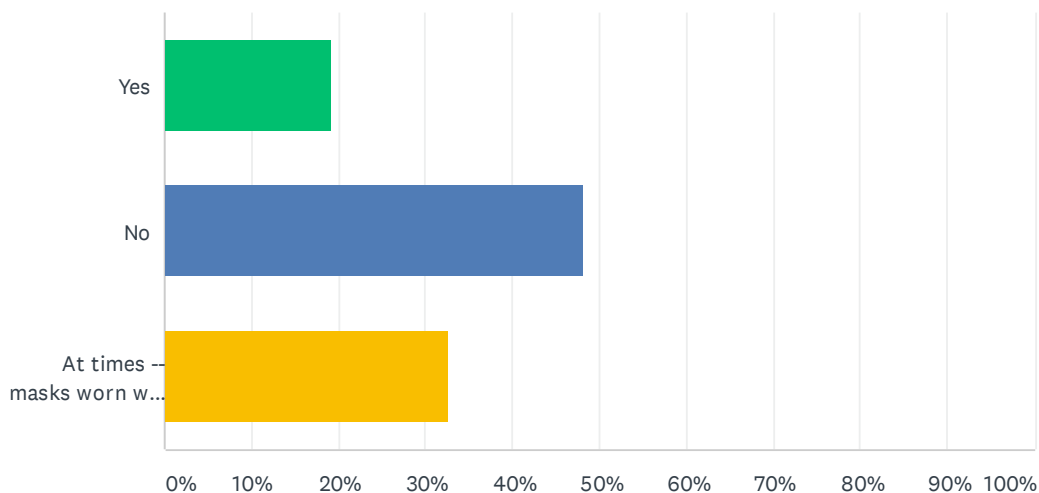

Q7 Do you feel wearing a face mask should be a condition of children attending school?

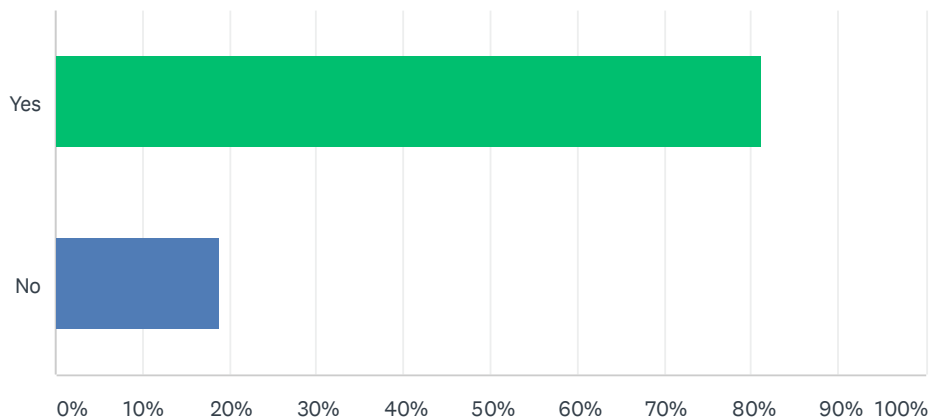

Q8 If wearing a face mask is a condition of your child attending school, will you send your child(ren)?

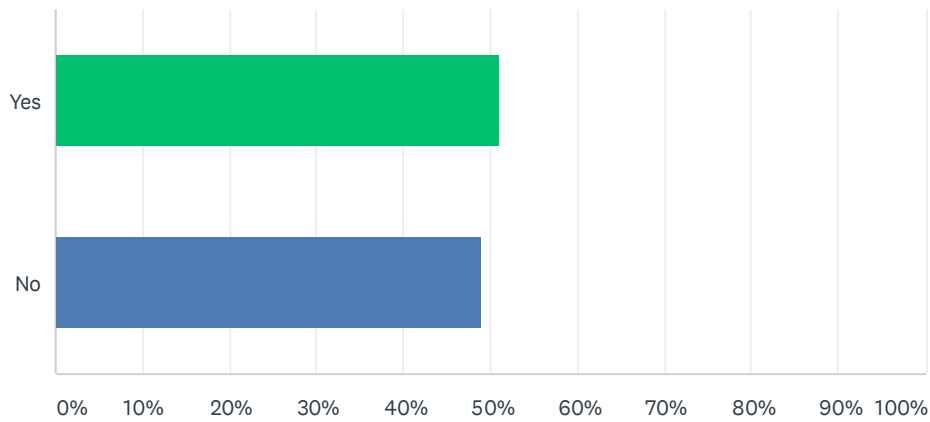

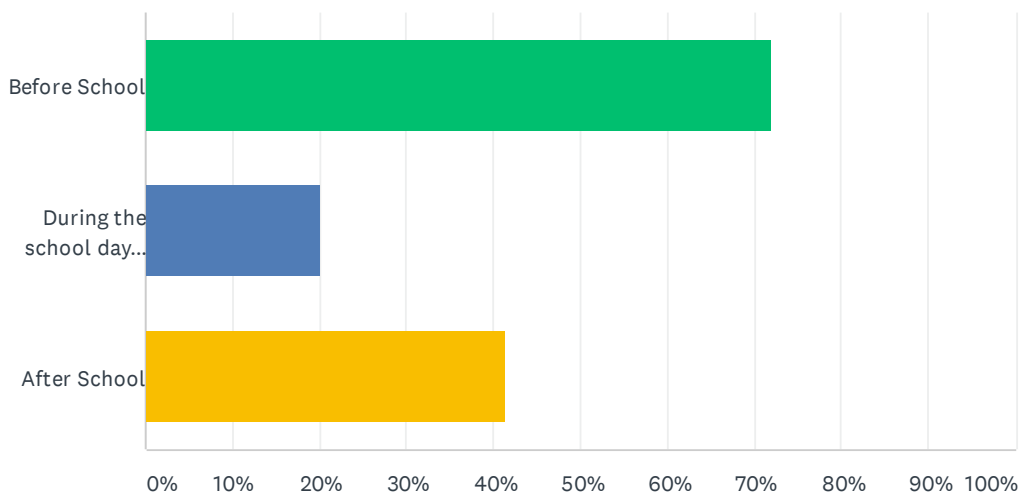

Q10 To help plan for staffing/spacing for our Child Care program/service, do you plan on having your child(ren) attend any of the following?

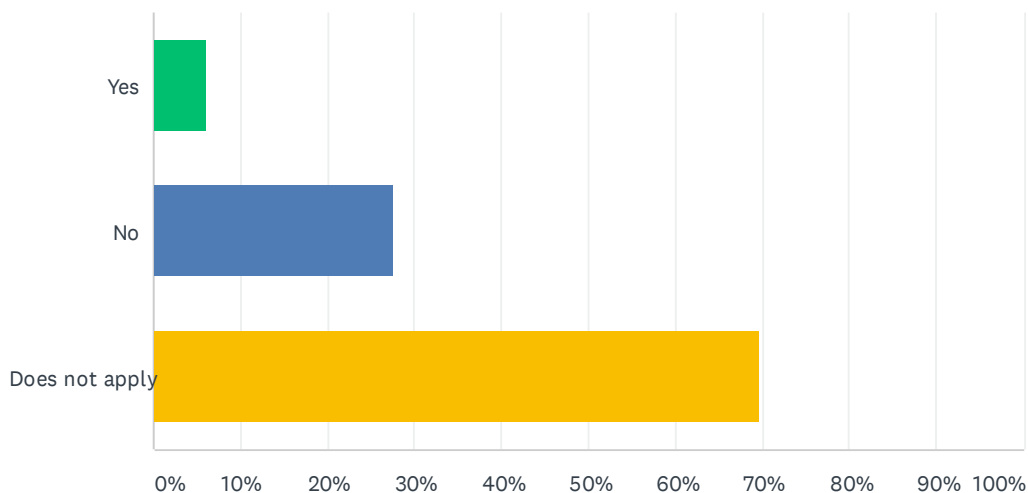

Q11 If you have younger children, would you plan to send your child to 3-year-old program offered by our Child Care?

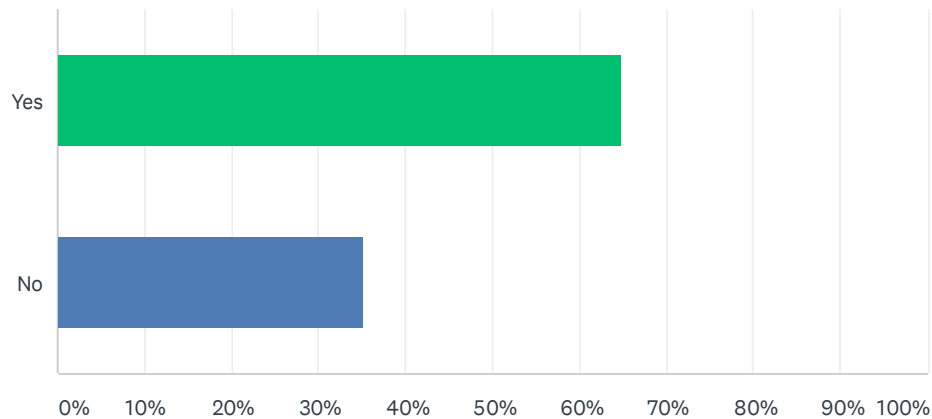

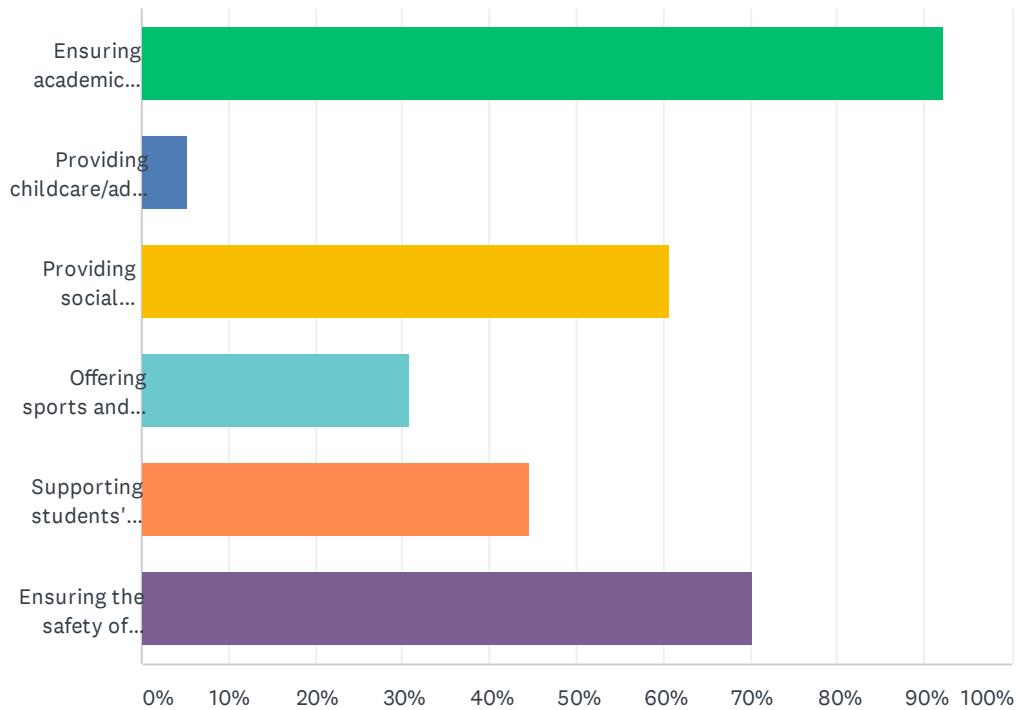

Q13 For the 2020-21 school year, what are your top 3 priorities for the District?

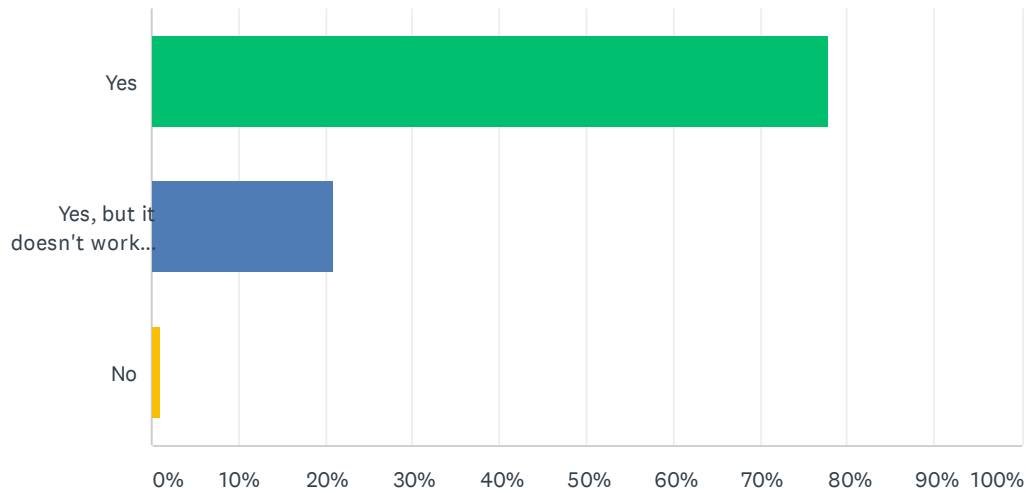

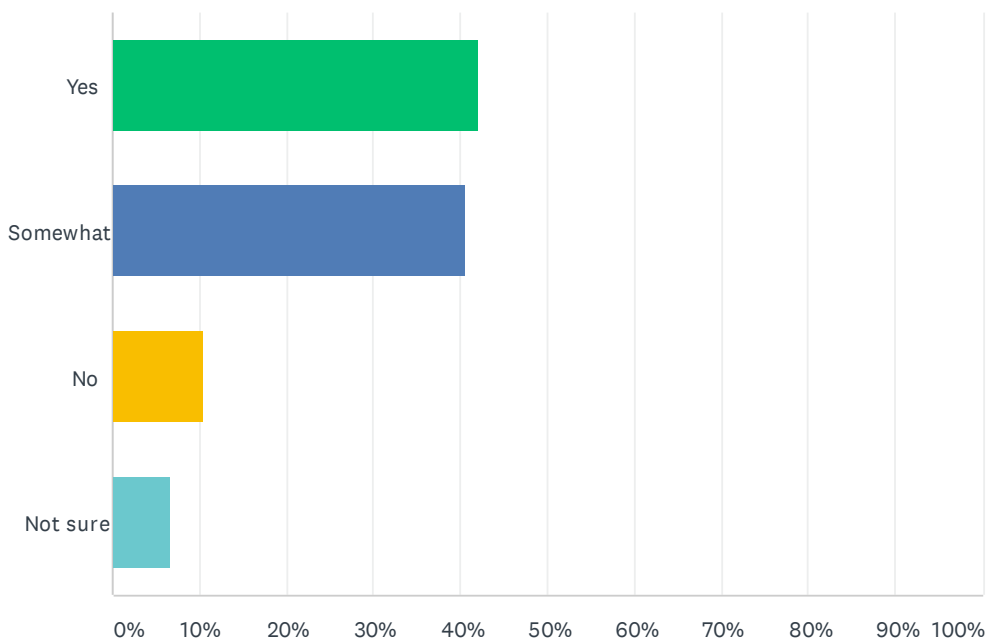

Q15 Is someone in your home available to help your child(ren) with their home/remote learning when they need it?

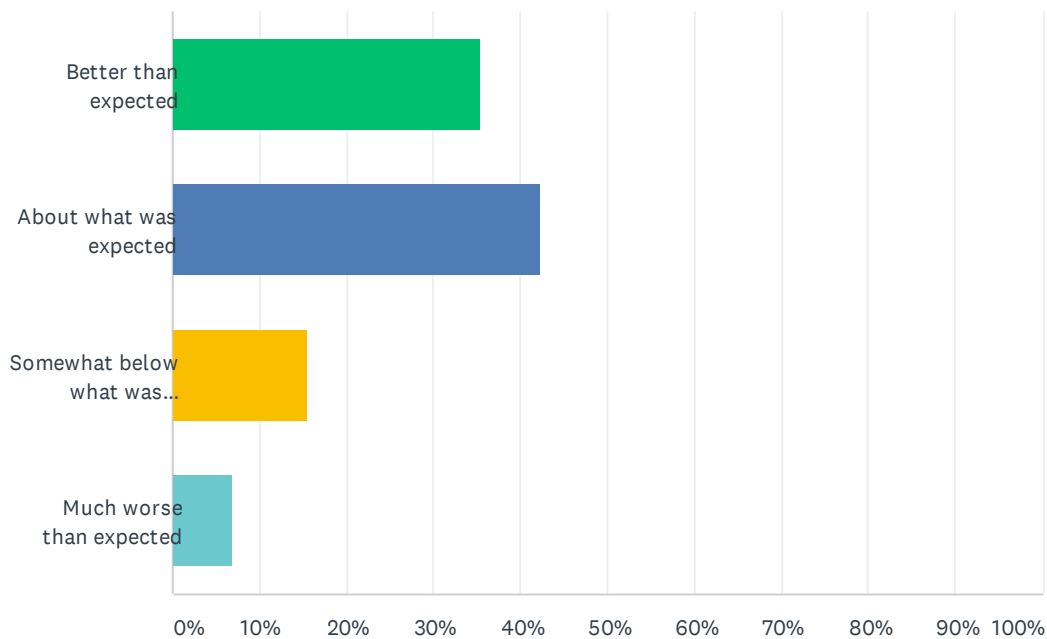

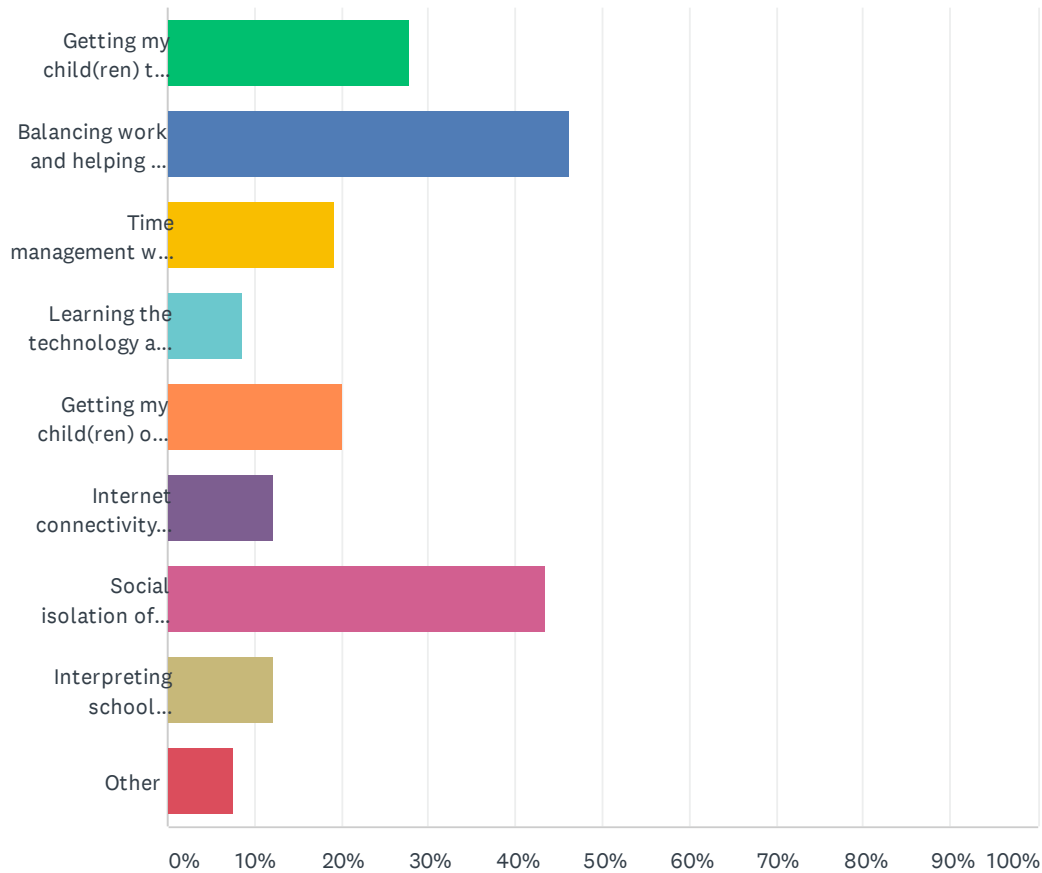

Q17 What was the hardest challenge for you during this difficult time?

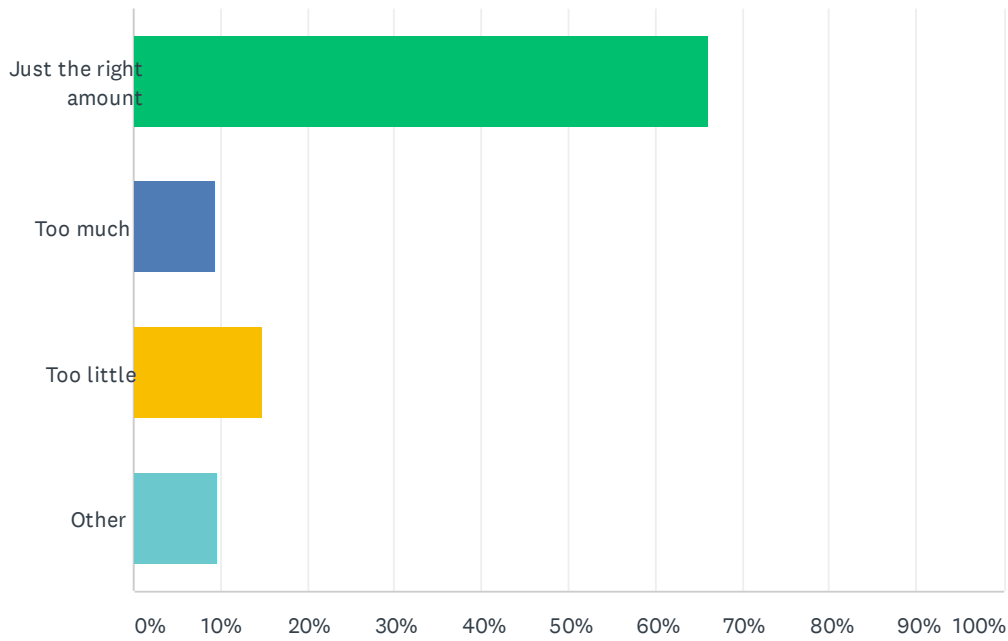

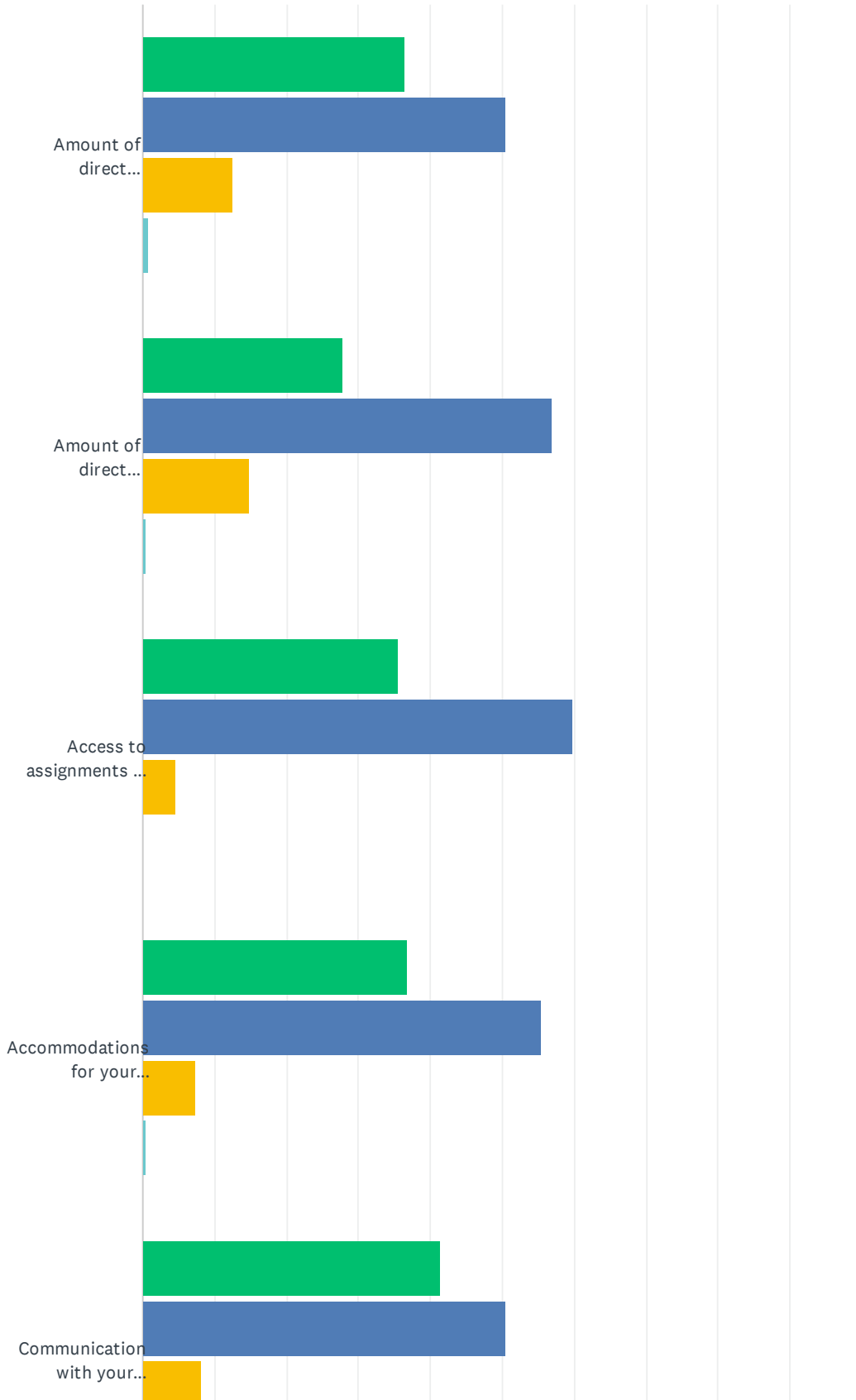

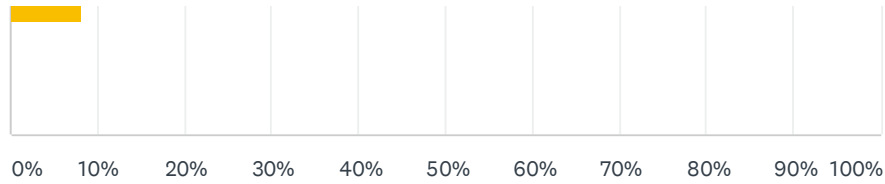

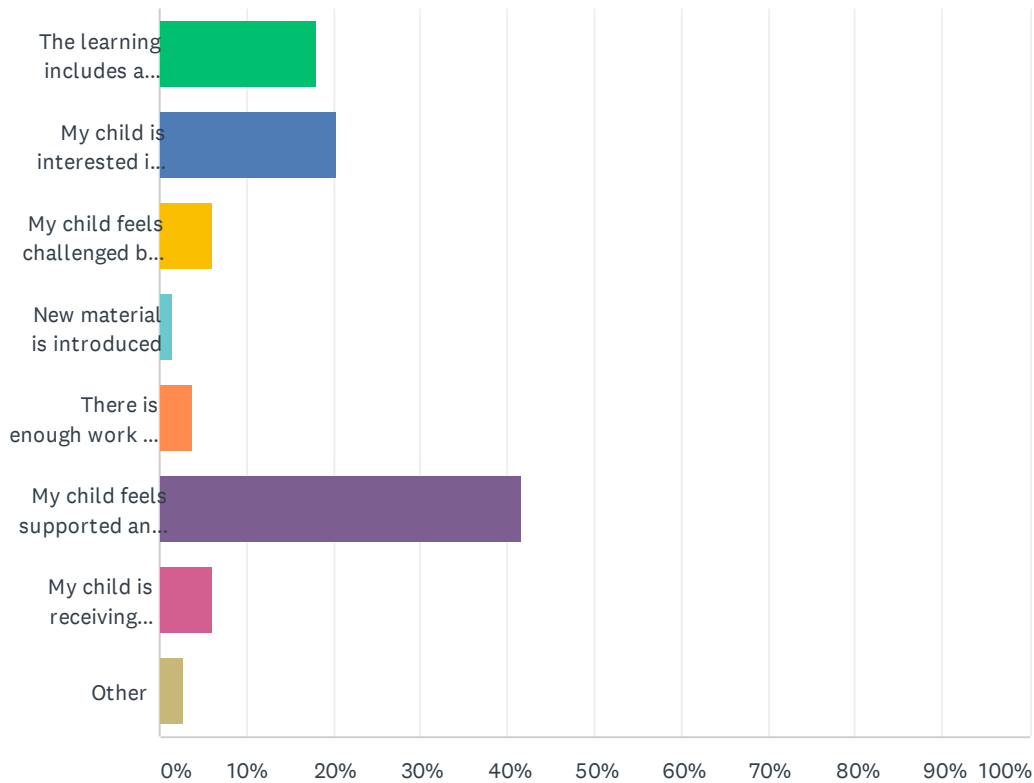
