WI National Guard COVID-19 Testing Sites Able to Test Children 12 Months or Older Starting February 8th

Starting February 8, all WI National Guard (WING) testing sites will be able to test children 12 months or older. The WING teams are being trained this week on techniques for swabbing younger children, and all members of the specimen collection teams will be equipped to do so going forward. No request is needed in order to expand this testing access at your site. In order to ensure everyone remains safe, WING service members will make a reasonable attempt to test the child, but will not perform or complete the specimen collection if there is risk of injury or extreme discomfort for either the child or service member.

As a reminder, the WI National Guard testing site at the Aging and Disability Resource Center in Sheboygan Falls is no longer open on Fridays. The site will remain **open on every Wednesday** during the newly revised hours of **9am-5pm**, until March 10th.
